Progress

1. We have a visitor, 110-pound chocolate lab, who needed a place to go to avoid euthanasia. Support is invited for his neuter surgery, medicine, plus large breed food. He loves dog treats.

2. A partner out of state decided to get a new ATV and donated his old John Deere Gator to us. It's a great workhorse and enjoyed by the dogs, who routinely jump up on the back for a better view. We have already used it to transport feed, hay, tools, and the pressure washer to clean horse troughs. When you visit, we can give you a tour.
3. Eight young puppies are saved and fostered in Maplesville after their mother was "dumped" then hit by a vehicle and died. We are supporting with puppy pads and food, hopefully more. Support is invited for food, pads, vet care. She may need portable pen or fencing soon. Foster care and adoption will likely be needed. You can donate on our web site and we can purchase food and supplies for her pick up for the puppies.

4. Three cats needing a home have moved into our barn loft. Their human mom visits to spend time with them and helps take care of litter box chores. This newlywed had to make a tough choice when her husband had to get medical attention due to allergic reactions. This old barn had many mice living in it and we've spent tens of hours clearing and cleaning to be better for cats and humans. So far, the presence of the cats encourages the mice to choose to be field mice more often. We intend to create a loft apartment.

Areas of need for the animals – do any inspire you?
